We have read two works since midterm: *Meditations* and *Mere Christianity*.

From each work, choose two sentences or passages that you judge to be important. Variety is good.

Type your four chosen sentences or passages onto a sheet and bring it with you to the test.

During the test, for each passage explain the *context* for the passage, what the passage *means*, and why you think it is an *important* passage for understanding *the work as a whole*.

You may refer to the sheet you brought with you with the four passages, but you may not use any other notes. I will supply the test booklets for you to write in.

Each question is worth 10 points. (Mechanically, that means you should plan to state 10 solid thoughts about each passage.)

Time: 50 minutes. (That means you should plan to write for about 12 minutes per passage.)
